Regions can share examples, either in English or their regional language, using the **survey template** as well as the evaluation framework guidelines and matrix.



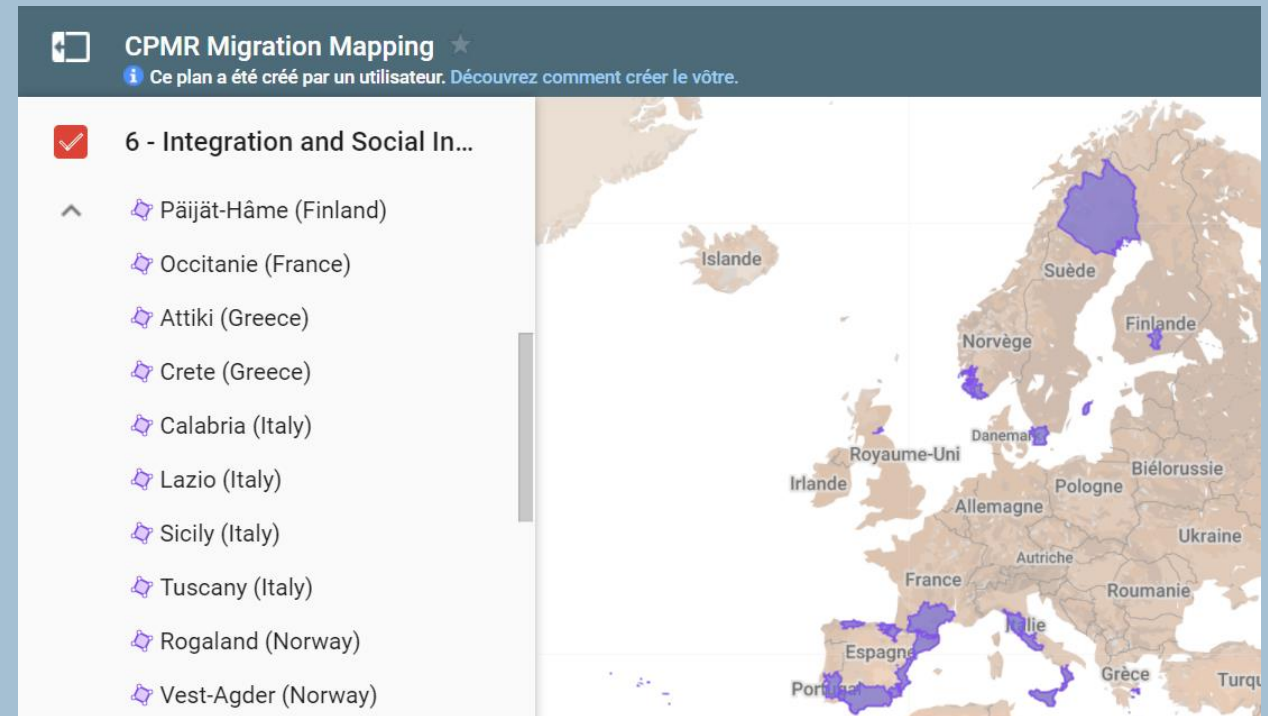
6.3 Database creation and mapping the practices

January to July 2021: building on and enhancing the existing **CPMR migration visual mapping tool**.

Creating a **database** to include all collected innovative integration practices and experiences.

The database will be complemented with an **interactive mapping** of the practices, facilitated with a **search tool** linked to the evaluation criteria.

The mapping will include integration actions from the **REGIN's** partner regions and beyond, paying special attention to other European regions.



How can you contribute?

- **Review and/or update information** as part of the CPMR Migration Visual Mapping (regional factsheet)
- **Share good practices** at regional level as well as examples of initiatives that were not as successful, **providing info on limitations / lessons learnt**
- **Use the evaluation matrix and guidelines** and provide feedback for improvement / adaptation
- **Share the evaluation framework, database of practices and interactive map** with relevant stakeholders

How can you benefit from results?

- **Mutual learning** between regions based on both successful and less successful practices
- Showcasing of regional integration actions, **networking and identifying expertise** in specific areas
- **Improving design, implementation and monitoring & evaluation** of integration practices within your region / adapting the evaluation framework collaborating with other regional stakeholders
