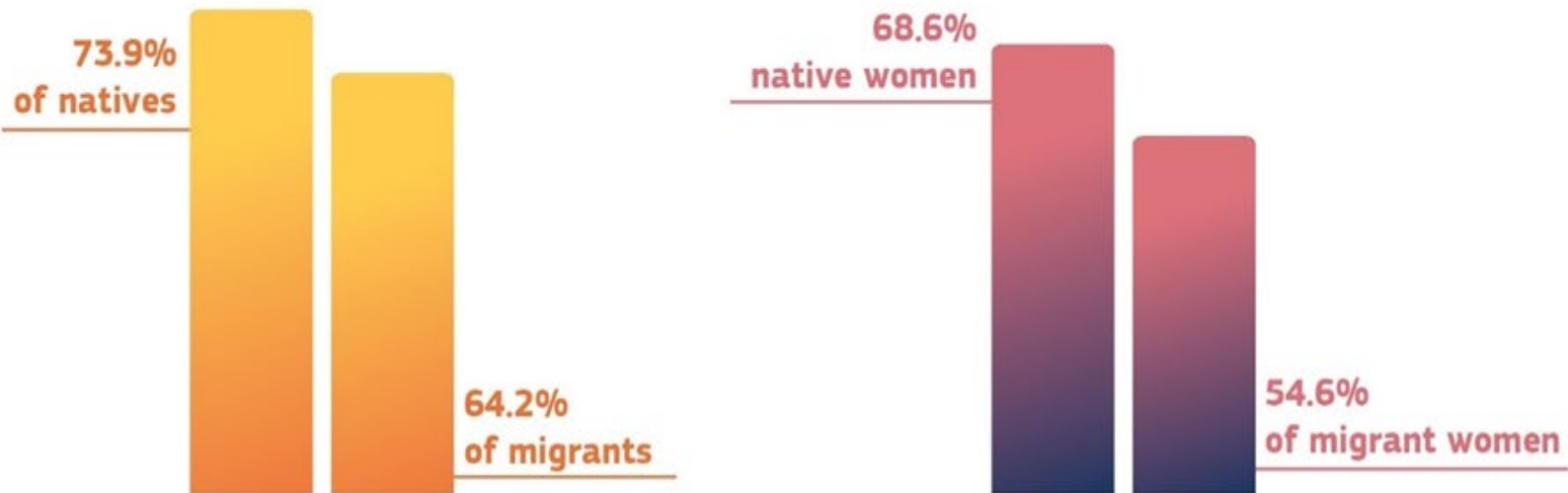

Share of population in employment among those of working-age (20-64)

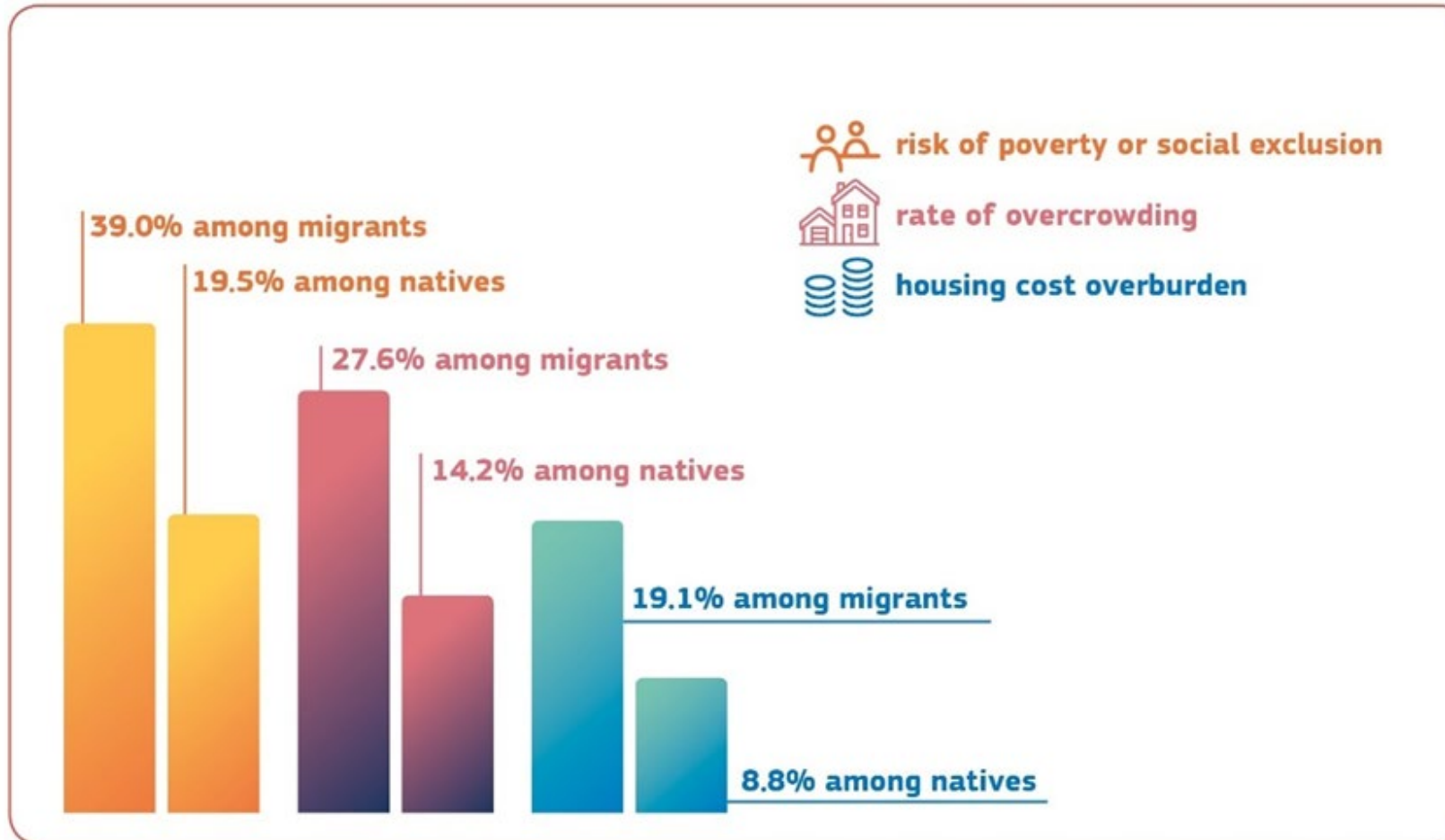


N.E.E.T young migrants (18-24) born outside the EU: **21%**

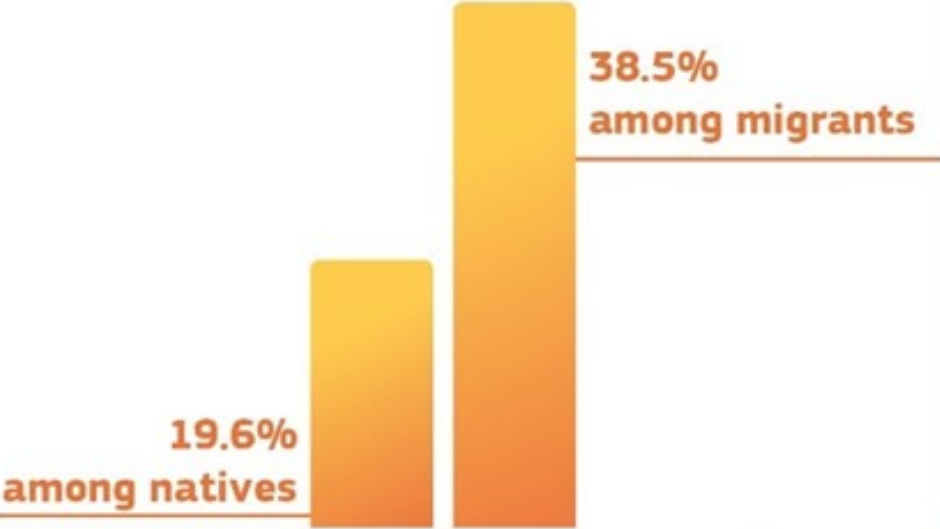

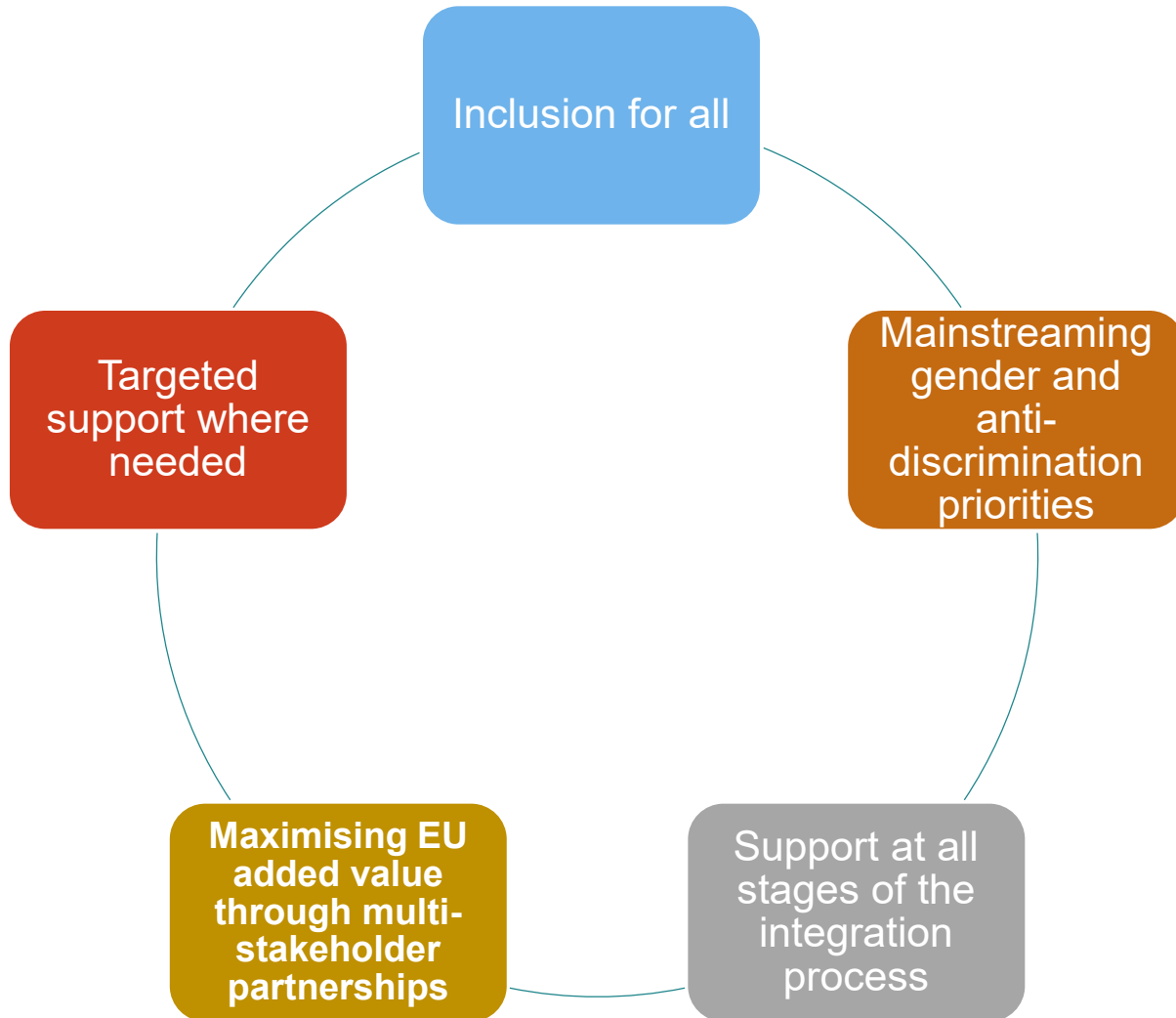
