





The Autonomous Region of the Azores' integration policies strongly reflect the migratory profile of the region, with most of the policies directed to the small-sized TCN population, as the region does not present a relevant BIP population. The region has rather well-established policies on migrant integration (56/100). However, the region could greatly benefit from improvements in the development and in particular in the evaluation of these policies. While the region has rather well-developed mechanisms for the inclusion of different actors in the decision-making process, it devotes limited financial resources to migrant integration policies.
