

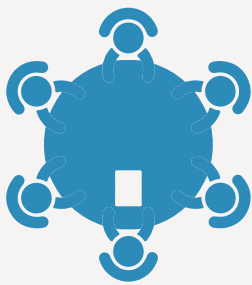
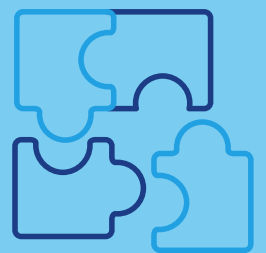


REGIN PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

REGIONAL POLICY AND OUTCOME INDICATORS

Policy indicators known as MIPEX-R (Migrant Integration Policy Regional Index) and outcome indicators for the six REGIN pilot regions - Azores, Campania, Catalonia, Murcia, Puglia and Skåne - are compiled in datasets, accompanied by a methodological note, and represent an overview of initial findings.



STAKEHOLDERS' CAPACITY BUILDING GUIDELINES

The REGIN stakeholders' capacity building guidelines provide a framework to discuss and identify opportunities and needs in the region and develop ideas for a pilot integration action, following the preliminary results of the MIPEX-R policy and outcome indicators.

TRAINING GUIDELINES

The REGIN training module, which consists of four sessions, is designed as a general framework that can be adapted to regional realities. It allows regional staff working in the delivery of different public services to migrants and refugees to upgrade their knowledge, awareness and skills on integration, inclusion, interculturality and diversity management.



TESTBED ON CIVIC AND HEALTH COMMUNICATIONS

Partnership Skåne has successfully completed its testbed providing individualised support to newly-arrived families in Skåne Region - Sweden, with a focus on civic and health communications on mental health, parenting and well-being.

EVALUATION FRAMEWORK AND MATRIX

The REGIN evaluation framework guidelines are based on criteria used by OECD: (Relevance, Effectiveness, Efficiency, Impact, Sustainability). The matrix represents a series of questions to analyse how an integration practice responds to each criterion. These tools can be used to support the design, monitoring and evaluation of regional integration actions.
